Subject:- Alaiya Blind School, Hebron.

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter received from the Director of Education on the question of the Blind School, Hebron.

2. I took the opportunity at the first meeting of the Social Welfare Advisory Board to place this letter before the Board and a discussion ensued on the treatment of the blind in Palestine (vide page 2 of Minutes forwarded on the 14th August - your ref. Y/100/44).

3. I was asked by the Board to prepare an estimate for the administration of the school as an activity of the Department of Social Welfare. The attached estimate has been submitted to the Board and has been approved in general by the members. If you approve these estimates I am prepared to take over the administration of the Blind School as a temporary measure until such special schools can be fitted into the framework of the Department of Education.

The amount of money required from the 1st of October to the 31st of March, would be as follows:-

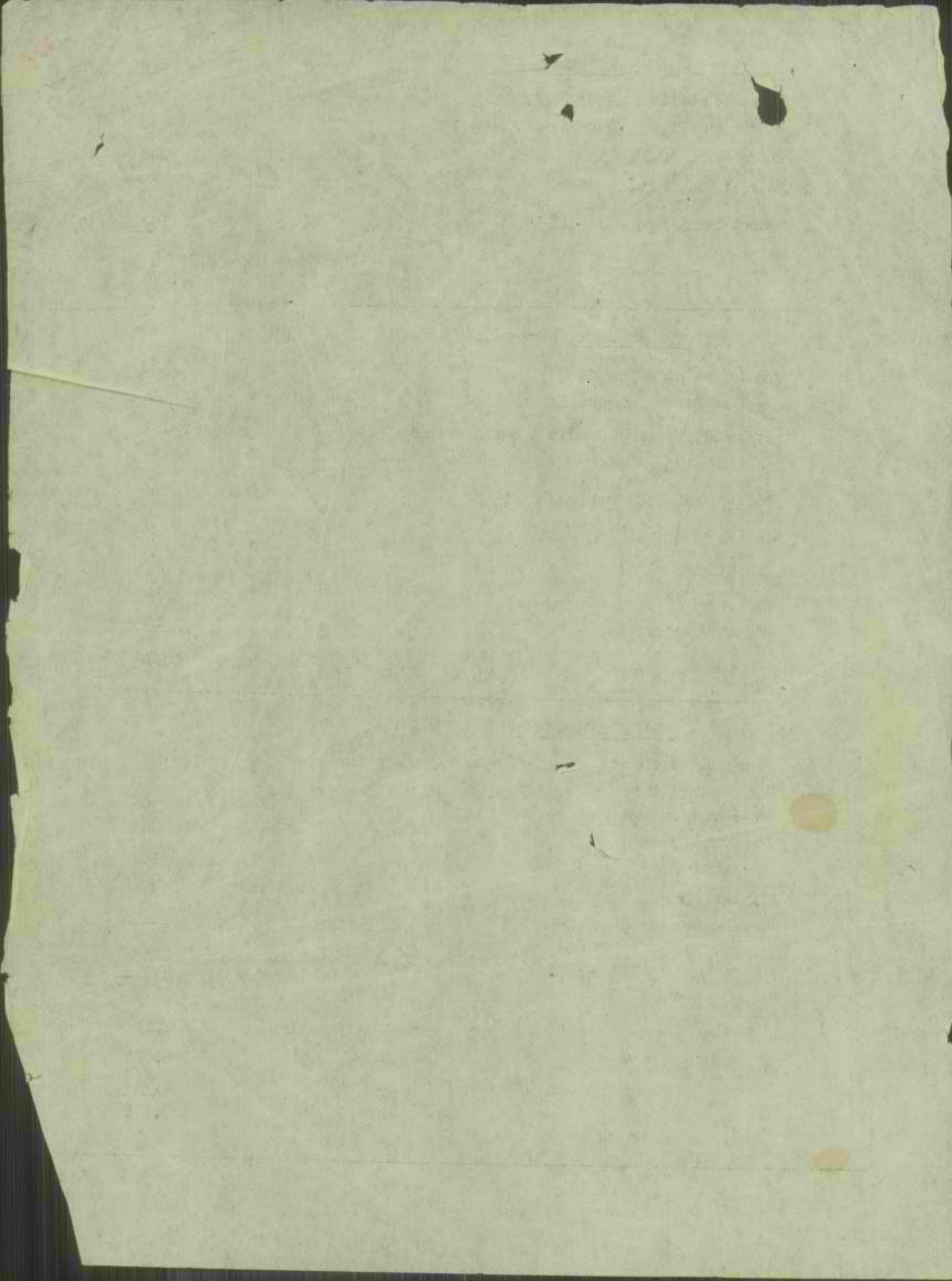

With reference to my conversation with you, some time ago, regarding the taking over by your Department of the 'Alaiya School for the Blind at Hebron, I attach herewith a statement giving particulars about the school.

I shall be obliged if you will let me know if you would be prepared to take over this school and hostel.

In particular the domestic arrangements at the hostel are urgently in need of reform and I should welcome any assistance you may be in a position to offer in advance of your taking over the whole enterprise. This Department has not got the necessary funds to take over the hostel which is a semi-private venture financed by the Headmaster.

It appears to me that the school belongs more properly to a Department dealing with welfare and handling charitable funds.
