The Moslem Supreme Council have sanctioned the expenditure of £P.15 for the improvement of the existing conditions in the above mentioned pharmacy.

The conditions to be complied with are as follows:-

Pharmacy:

1. Procure a set of pharmacy bottles and ointment jars as outlined in Nos.13 & 14 of Special Conditions for Pharmacies. Glass stoppered bottles, uniform in shape and size which should have painted labels, should also be provided for stock preparations.
2. All shelves inside the cupboards and dispensing counters should be white painted and also all external wood work wherever this is considered necessary.
3. Procure external use and poison labels as prescribed in this office letter No.708 of 23rd September, 1929.
4. If possible to place marble top on dispensing counter.

Laboratory:

1. Two sets of shelves each $1\frac{1}{2}$ x 2 metres should be fitted in this section, vide No.17(e) of Special Conditions.
2. The existing table to be made into two, one of which to be fitted with a marble top for dispensing.
3. No.5 b & c of Special Conditions in respect of the washing arrangement.
4. As the installation of piped water supply is not possible, a special tank should be fitted above the sink and the water should be from a source approved by the Department of Health vide No.5(a) of Special Conditions.
5. All wood work should be painted with white paint and the walls when no fixtures are placed should also be painted white enamel paint at least 2 metres from the floor vide No.5(c) of Special Conditions.

It is suggested that a time limit of one month be given for complying with the above mentioned conditions.
